

Racing Checklist

Here is a list of things that need to be taken care of before participating in your first race.

Note: These do not apply to the Chase Race Series

Acquire an Autobahn Competition License

- Complete the License Application form, be sure to list all prior race experience and schools
- Have a Dr. perform the needed tasks and complete the Physical Examination form
- Submit these forms to the Competition License Steward Tom Bagley
tombagley@autobahncc.com
- If more experience is required sign up for an approved racing school
- All forms can be found at www.autobahnmembers.com under the member racing tab

Personnel Gear

- Helmet must be SA2005 or newer
- Drivers suit, shoes and gloves must meet the FIA/SFI standards stated in the rulebook
- A head and neck restraint device, HANS or similar, is required.

Race Car Prep

- Check the rulebook to make sure your car has all the required safety items in place.
- Your car must pass an annual technical inspection. This can be performed only by the following people- Mike Gritter, Joe Griffin, Tony Kester, Tom Bagley, and Francesco D'Avola.
- Reserve a car number with Mike Gritter. Duplicate car numbers are not allowed in a race, check to make sure your desired number is not already in use.
- Most classes require an on board camera such as a GoPro or similar
- All cars must display an official Member Racing sticker, one on each side of the car.

Rulebook

- Read the entire rulebook paying particular attention to the flags and passing rules as well as the procedures
- You are personally responsible for knowing and understanding the rules, if you don't understand something please ask.

Register for your first race

- When the tasks above are completed you are ready to race! Simply send an email to mikegritter@autobahncc.com to register for the next race. It is advisable to do this several days in advance the first time so there is time to confirm that you have completed the necessary steps.
